Sermon Series: *GRACE ENCOUNTERS* - Sermon Title: *THE SCANDAL OF GRACE*

Text: Matthew 20:1-16

An op-ed contributor in a secular magazine was offended when he encountered this story told by Jesus. The writer questioned Jesus' ethical standards in treating the hardworking people unfairly. You might have the same reaction when you read about how the laborers were compensated and you exclaim, "Hey! That's not fair."

But Jesus introduced His story by stating, "For the Kingdom of Heaven is like..." The economy of this earthly kingdom where we live is different from Heaven's economy. The math equations in Kingdom of Heaven are not compatible to this earthly / worldly kingdom of minimum wage laws.

This world may call Jesus' calculations as fuzzy math but the Bible calls it GRACE!

There are 4 lessons that we learn from this account from Jesus:

1. A LESSON ABOUT TIMING: You can respond to God's invitation to join His Kingdom at any time
2. A LESSON ABOUT GRACE: All who respond to God's invitation will receive all that is to receive
3. A LESSON ABOUT AUTHORITY: God is sovereign; He has the right to do what He wants to do
4. A LESSON ABOUT ATTITUDE: Be thankful for God's blessings without comparing yourself to others
