BABY DEDICATION

In Grace Abounds Church, we don't do infant baptism nor “christening” rites for a young child. But we practice baby dedication.

Dedicating a baby acknowledges God's sovereignty not only over the child but also over Mom and Dad. Parents present their child before God asking for grace and wisdom in carrying out their parental responsibilities. Parents also want the church family

to help them pray for their child so that their baby would one day trust Jesus as Savior for the forgiveness of sin and the assurance of eternal life with God.

Children are a gift from God. Psalm 127:3 proclaims that “Sons are a heritage from the Lord; children a reward from Him.” Christian parents must recognize that children belong first and foremost to God. In His goodness, God gives children as gifts to parents who have the awesome responsibility of caring for this gift and also the wonderful privilege of enjoying this gift. In the light of this truth, it is only proper and appropriate that children be dedicated back to God.

In 1 Samuel 1, Hannah presented her son Samuel to the Lord. In Luke 2, Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple and presented Him to God.

In the same way, Ramiro and Daisy are bringing Mia Alessia before the Lord in a dedication ceremony with the GAC family as witnesses.
