



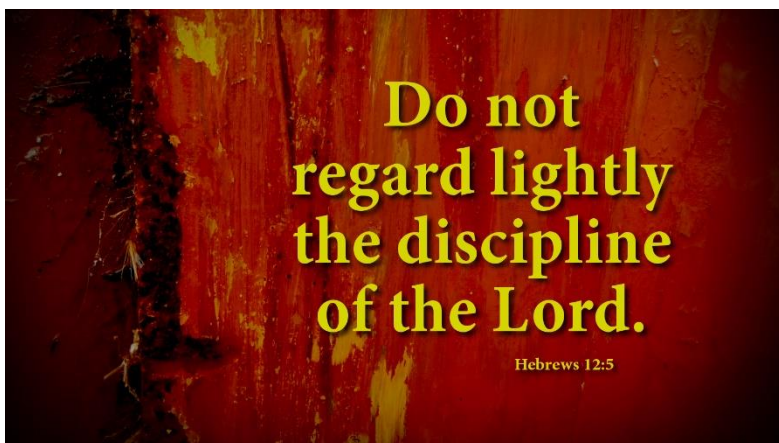

PASTOR'S CORNER



I am inviting you to join me in the **21x21 Prayer & Fasting** which begins on March 21 up to April 21 which is Resurrection Sunday.

Fasting is a God-ordained expression of our belief that we have tasted and seen that the Lord is good (Psalm 34:8) – so good that there are times we're satisfied to feast on Him instead of the food that the Lord made to sustain us.

Fasting is a temporary, physical demonstration that you believe the eternal, spiritual reality of the Gospel, that *"Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God"* (Matthew 4:4).

Here are some of the reasons we pray with fasting:

1. Praying with fasting bring miraculous breakthroughs in physical and spiritual healing. (Matthew 17:14-21 in the KJV and ESV)
2. Praying with fasting open doors of opportunity. (Nehemiah Chapters 1-2)
3. Praying with fasting bring new seasons of ministry. After going through a period of fasting, Jesus was empowered to begin His public ministry (Luke 4). As a result of worshiping and fasting, the modern missionary movement was birthed (Acts 13).
4. Prayer with fasting give us insight to spiritual warfare and how to defeat the enemy. (Daniel 10)
